I am requesting funding for the San Pasqual Reservation Fire Department Emergency Operations Center Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is San Pasqual Band of Mission Indians, located at 16400 Kumeyaay Way, Valley Center, CA 92082. The funding would be used to build a Tribal Emergency Operations Center, housing fire and police departments, personnel, equipment, and vehicles. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will enable San Pasqual fire and police to serve the reservation and surrounding departments and communities, including Valley Center and San Diego County.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 203 of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5133), as amended by Section 1234, National Public Infrastructure Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation, of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act (DRRA) of 2018.
